HELPING FAMILIES AVOID HOMELESSNESS

Foreclosures and evictions in Maricopa County are among the highest in the nation. The spiraling effect of job loss or reduced hours or the cost of unexpected medical care leaves many hard working families on the brink of homelessness. Many families desperately need help.

The Nina Mason Pulliam Charitable Trust responded by forging a partnership with City of Phoenix and Maricopa County Community Action Programs in an Emergency Funding Initiative to provide one-time-need rent and mortgage assistance to families who otherwise would lose their home or apartment. The idea is to keep as many people as possible out of the financial crater caused by foreclosure or eviction. The partners expect that at least 750 families will receive assistance through this collaborative effort.
